

Dear ministry partner,

I'm reaching out with both good news and a significant challenge, and I'm asking for your help.

First, the difficult news.

In December, the Living with Power Hospitality House suffered severe water damage due to a burst pipe. Nearly the entire house was impacted, and despite our efforts, our insurance claim has been denied. While we are challenging this decision, we now face the monumental task of rebuilding, with costs estimated at \$200,000.

We had only had the Hospitality House for a year, but it was already becoming a place of refuge and restoration—a safe space where people found healing, community, and hope. Losing its use has been heartbreaking, especially as we were just beginning to see its impact.



Now, the good news.

Despite this setback, our global ministry has continued to thrive and expand:

- Just last month, we partnered with Warm Hands to build a space that will soon reach thousands of women and children with hope.
 - Our pharmacy is thriving, serving over 1,500 people each month.
- Our Douris center is bursting at the seams, and the students we tutor are seeing a remarkable increase in their grades.
 - Both our sewing and women's health education programs have doubled in size.
 - · We've also launched a new partnership in Uganda, bringing hope to even more communities.

All these efforts align with our mission to spread PEACE—Provide hope, Equip women, Assist the poor, Care for the sick, and Educate the next generation.

Even as we face the challenge of rebuilding the Hospitality House, our work overseas has not slowed down. God has continued to provide, and we trust that He will guide us through this too.
